The Common University Entrance Test (CUET UG) is conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) for admission to undergraduate programmes in central universities and participating institutions across India. It serves as a single entrance test for admission to over 45 central universities and many other participating universities, replacing individual university entrance exams. CUET has been mandatory for admission to central universities since 2022, making it one of the largest entrance exams in India with lakhs of candidates applying annually.

## Eligibility and Exam Pattern

### CUET Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates must have passed or be appearing in Class 12 or equivalent from a recognized board. There is no minimum percentage requirement for appearing in the CUET exam. Age limit and other criteria may vary as per individual university requirements. Students from any stream (Arts, Science, Commerce) can apply, and both Indian and international students are eligible. Final year Class 12 students can also apply. Candidates can appear for CUET from any state or board.

### CUET Exam Pattern:

CUET has a flexible structure with multiple sections and subject choices:

- **Section IA: Languages (13 Languages):**
  - Candidates can choose a maximum of 2 languages.
  - 50 questions per language, 45 to be attempted.
  - 45 minutes per language.
  - Focuses on reading comprehension and language proficiency.
- **Section IB: Languages (20 Languages):**
  - Candidates can choose a maximum of 9 languages from Section IA and IB combined.
  - 50 questions per language, 45 to be attempted.
  - 45 minutes per language.
  - Focuses on reading comprehension.
- **Section II: Domain Specific Subjects (27 Subjects):**
  - Candidates can choose a maximum of 6 domain subjects.
  - Each subject has 50 questions, 45 to be attempted.
  - 45 minutes per subject.
  - Subjects include Accountancy, Biology, Business Studies, Chemistry, Computer Science, Economics, English, Geography, History, Mathematics, Physics, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, etc. Choose based on programme and university requirements.
- **Section III: General Test:**
  - Covers General Knowledge, Current Affairs, General Mental Ability, Numerical Ability, Quantitative Reasoning, Logical and Analytical Reasoning.
  - 75 questions, 60 to be attempted.
  - 60 minutes duration.
  - Optional, but required by some universities (e.g., Delhi University).

### Marking Scheme:

- +5 marks for each correct answer.
- -1 mark for each incorrect answer.
- 0 marks for unattempted questions.

### Mode and Duration:

- Computer-Based Test (CBT) conducted online.
- Duration varies based on the number of subjects chosen, typically 3 to 6 hours.

**Important Note:** Always check specific university and programme requirements for subject combinations before filling out the CUET application.

## CUET Subject Selection Strategy

### Understanding Subject Selection:

CUET offers flexible subject selection tailored to target universities and programmes. Researching university requirements is crucial, as different institutions and courses have specific subject prerequisites. You can choose subjects across different streams, irrespective of your Class 12 stream. Strategic selection is key to maximizing your admission chances.

### Domain Subject Selection Strategy:

1. **Research:** Identify your target universities and programmes.
2. **Check Requirements:** Note down mandatory subject requirements for your desired programmes. (e.g., BA often needs humanities, BSc needs science, BCom needs commerce subjects).
3. **Strength Assessment:** Choose subjects you are strong in and have studied in Class 12 for better scores.
4. **Flexibility:** You can choose up to 6 domain subjects, offering broad options. However, balance this with preparation load.

### Language Selection Strategy:

- You can choose up to 9 languages combined from Section IA and IB.
- Most universities require at least one language. English is commonly required.
- Choose languages you are proficient in.
- Regional languages can be an advantage for state-focused central universities.
- Language scores can be used for tie-breaking.

### General Test Strategy:

- The General Test (Section III) is optional but required by some universities (like Delhi University).
- It tests general knowledge, current affairs, reasoning, and numerical ability.
- If required by your target universities, prepare thoroughly. If not, you can skip it to reduce your exam burden.

### Sample Subject Combinations:

- **BA English:** English domain subject + Humanities (History, Political Science, Sociology)
- **BSc:** Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (PCM) or Physics, Chemistry, Biology (PCB) based on specialization.
- **BCom:** Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics, Mathematics.
- **BBA:** Business Studies, Economics, Mathematics, English.
- **BA Psychology:** Psychology + Humanities subjects.

### University-wise Requirements (Examples):

- **Delhi University:** Often requires the General Test for most programmes.
- **JNU:** Specific subject requirements per programme.
- **BHU:** Check faculty-wise requirements.
- **AMU & Jamia Millia Islamia:** Programme-specific requirements.
