## Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for CLAT UG, candidates must satisfy the following criteria:

- **Educational Qualification:** Candidates who have completed or will be appearing for their 12th standard examinations (or equivalent) from a recognized board are eligible.
- **Minimum Marks:** Generally, candidates belonging to the General/OBC/Specially Abled Persons categories need to secure at least 45% marks in their qualifying examination. Candidates belonging to SC/ST categories need to secure at least 40% marks.
- **Age Limit:** There is no upper age limit for appearing in CLAT.
